The Chief Constable launched the Gwent Police Awards on 23 January 2012 and they include those the Force has traditionally given, and offer some new categories, in line with the operational and business challenges we currently face.

We are asking for your help to identify those who would be worthy of recognition due to their work, actions or service to the communities within Gwent. The three award categories we would like you to consider are:

Working In Partnership Award

- Awarded to recognise the importance of working in partnership to deliver improved services to the citizens of Gwent.
- This is a joint award and an individual or group of people can be nominated for this award but it should include both Gwent Police staff as well as partners, e.g. Local Authorities, Voluntary Sector, citizens. Nominations must outline clearly what partnership working has taken place, outcome of improving awareness, involvement or service delivery has been. This award is not about our everyday partnership working but new innovations, creating approaches and achieving better outcomes.

Gwent Active Citizen Award

- This prestigious award is given to members of the public for meritorious and public-spirited actions, which is of great assistance to the police and the community. Awards are made both for bravery and also for other meritorious actions.

Diversity in Action Award

- Awarded to recognise the excellent work of a Gwent Police individual or team in the area of diversity, e.g. age, disability, gender, gender, re-assignment, race, religion or belief, sexual orientation, vulnerable groups.
- Nominations must focus on delivering excellent policing services to communities and/or evidence clear policing success, e.g. Enhanced community confidence, enhanced report of particular incidents from key groups, disruption of criminal activity, arrest and charging offenders.
