Nature Zone

This workshop is all about exploring the environment and thinking about its future. The workshop aims to increase participants' awareness of the environment and includes lots of fun activities and things to make and do both indoors and outdoors with children.

Culture Zone

This workshop is all about exploring different cultures and religions. The workshop aims to increase participants' awareness of the traditions of different cultures and how they can use the activities with children.

Focus on Food

This workshop aims to help participants promote healthy eating in a way that will motivate children to understand and adjust their eating habits through fun and creative ways.

Taste of Play

For people interested in working with children in a play setting, in this workshop, you will find out what working in out of school childcare is all about:

- the importance of play for children
- the role of a playworker
- careers in playwork – where they are, skills you'll need, qualifications and how to get them.

Active Club Pack

Experience the Active Club pack which is full of resources to encourage physical play activity and ways to help build the confidence, physical skills and fitness of children and young people.

Playing Fair

Playing Fair addresses Equal Opportunities legislation, anti-discrimination and good practice in out of school childcare settings. This course provides play activities that can be used in out of school clubs.

NB: This course forms part of the Level 2 Diploma in Playwork.

Promoting and Supporting Positive Relationships in a Play Setting

This 6 hour course provides information for playworkers about the different types of relationships that exist in a play environment taking account all of the different stakeholders who are involved in attending and supporting children and young people's opportunities for play. The course looks at strategies for supporting effective communication, promoting positive relationships and dealing with conflict should it arise.

NB: This course forms part of the Level 2 Diploma in Playwork.

Health & Safety

The course provides knowledge and understanding to develop and follow safe working practices within childcare and play environments. It provides clear guidelines on health and safety requirements in the workplace, use of equipment, including play equipment; and conducting risk assessments, and the fire risk assessment regulations.

NB: This course forms part of the Level 2 Diploma in Playwork.

Children's Rights and Participation

This course will help you to ensure that children that you work with are encouraged and able to fully participate in making choices and decisions about all aspects of the play setting ranging from choosing activities to interviewing prospective staff. It introduces students to the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) and the National Children and Young People's Participation Standards in Wales.

NB: This course forms part of the Level 2 Diploma in Playwork.

CACHE Level 3 Transition to Playwork (QCF) (NVQ)

This qualification is based on the National Occupational Standards for Playwork and has been developed for early years practitioners who would like to broaden their knowledge and work in playwork settings.

The units cover the theories and principles of play and playwork and how to support the needs and rights of children to create diverse, inclusive play environments. They also cover how to support children and young people to manage risk, establishing and maintaining links with other organisations and individuals, and organisational frameworks.

Learners will need to be working or volunteering in a play setting so that they can draw on and reflect on their experience. There is no work based assessment for this award.

Learners will need to hold a Level 3 early years qualification that covers the National Occupational Standards for Children's Care Learning and Development.

Delivered over a term (2.5 hour sessions)

CACHE Level 2 Diploma in Playwork (QCF) (NVQ)

Based on the Playwork Principles and the National Occupational Standards for Playwork, this qualification is a nationally recognised Level 2 qualification. It is recognised by CSSIW. The qualification is delivered using a variety of delivery and assessment methods both in group learning and in the workplace. The full Diploma units are assessed in the workplace and all learners will need to be in employment or volunteering in a play setting and have approval from their employer to enrol on this course.

Please note that due to eligibility requirements, there is a separate application form to enrol on this course. Please contact cwmamynydd@clybiauplantcymru.org Places are limited, and those with a placement in an out of school childcare club will be given priority. Please contact us if you need assistance in obtaining a placement.

We deliver workshops directly in childcare clubs on request and we can offer a limited number of FREE workshops as part of this project. These are a great way to train your staff in their workplace whilst they are working with the children.
